EVENT OVERVIEW

The Northern Lights Trail begins in Flinders Street and takes you on a walking tour of the CBD, showcasing magical light displays and features an augmented reality (AR) adventure!

This free experience will have something for all ages to enjoy – day or night!

DAILY PROGRAM

5pm

Head into the city before sunset and check out the Festive Flags in Flinders Street – the flags were designed by local students from all different year levels. Also be sure to check out the vibrant and lively street art murals on buildings and down hidden alleyways and keep your eyes peeled for signage near the murals to see the artworks transform with AR. 6pm

Visit one of the many local businesses in the CBD and grab a bite to eat before the lights turn on at 7pm.

7pm

Start the Northern Lights Trail – we recommend starting from the large Christmas Tree and walking across Victoria Bridge into Flinders Street!

11pm

Lights turn off for the evening.

5 – 9pm

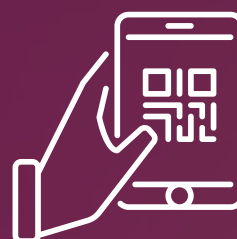
